We are a licensed Agency in Minnesota and Wisconsin, and are bonded and insured.

R. Steven Rogers Investigations (2016 – current):

With experience accumulated since 2013 I applied for and received a Private Detective license in Minnesota in June, 2016. This was shortly followed by receiving licenses in Iowa and Wisconsin. We are also bonded and insured. Our focus is primarily legal support services; however we offer all of the usual services as well, including; Case and Evidence Analysis, Background Checks, Skip Tracing, Service of Process, Surveillance and more.

We have been the Chief Investigators for a number of high-profile cases including the 2013 Terrance Franklin case where my work was highlighted in Time Magazine in June of 2021 (<https://time.com/6075094/terrance-franklin-shooting/>).

In reference to this case, Hennepin County District Attorney Mike Freeman is quoted as saying we performed “extraordinary investigative work” (<https://time.com/6084463/terrance-franklin-prosecutor/>).

This case is now under review as of October 2021 for possible criminal charges and the involved officers have all retained counsel (<https://time.com/6104087/minneapolis-police-lawyers-terrance-franklin/>).

I also was responsible for the investigation into the Dan Rassier case, who was falsely accused of the kidnapping and murder of Jacob Wetterling. This was a massive undertaking with the case file being around 40,000 pages. Our work led to a number of media reports and a series of podcasts about the failures of law enforcement that not only could have prevented the Wetterling murder but proved they had the evidence the entire time that was needed to solve the case.

Executive protection was required with the presence of Special Envoy for Northern Ireland and former White House Chief of Staff Mick Mulvaney, Mike Lindell and potential appearances from President Trump and / or his son Donald Trump Jr. As well as other speakers. This involved coordination with local hospitals and establishment of multiple landing zones for Medevac helicopters and other practices common to high level details.

With a anticipated crowd of well over 5,000 and a convoy of hundreds of vehicles that stretched for many miles, I was responsible for route security, advance vehicles to secure overpasses and coordination with the State Patrol.

One on One Control Tactics Instructor Training – 5 day course (August 2017):

One On One Control Tactics (O3CT) is designed for the realities of law enforcement officers, the conditions they work in, and the restrictions placed on them by the public, department policies, as well as state and federal statutes. It is one of the few systems to integrate handcuffing into its overall methods - teaching officers to establish and maintain control prior to the actual application of handcuffs.

Developed by Steven Jimerfield, a retired Alaska State Trooper, O3CT allows you to control subjects throughout the contact, from first approach to arrest and handcuffing - in various situations including: standing, prone, actively aggressive, inclement weather, inside vehicles, and in confined spaces. The system gives you the skills to control and restrain suspects wherever the job may take you. The system is medically reviewed and supported as safe for officers and suspects. It is a court defensible system with documented support in its effectiveness and low instance of complaints or injuries.

Talon Instructor Certification (February, 2017):

A unique defensive tool designed to elicit immediate pain compliance with minimal training for Law Enforcement, EMS, Fire and others without causing physical injury.

L.O.C.K.U.P. ® 5 Day Arrest and Control Instructor Training (June 2016):

Created for law enforcement, security and military personnel, the L.O.C.K.U.P. ® (Law Officers Combat Kinetics Unarmed Panoply) program teaches arrest and control maneuvers for all levels of physical resistance and aggression. With a primary focus on techniques for UNARMED police combat, L.O.C.K.U.P.®, developed with over 60 years of combined law enforcement and martial arts training, combines dynamic arrest and control tactics with basic fighting skills and

applications. The result is that police, security and military personnel can better protect themselves and the public they are sworn to serve.

Command Considerations to Terror Response

When terror or emergency strikes, the commander in the field is on their own. Real-time events do not allow procedure-checking in the books, and things are

always more fluid than in procedure- because of this field commanders need to know all of the challenges, threats, and windfalls that he or she may have when things get real. With a requirement that responders must safely conduct appropriate response actions during the pre / post detonation periods of a terror incident, the lecture addressed the hazards associated with terrorist incidents and include considerations for the critical tasks associated with scene safety and security.

First responders can benefit from utilizing the research done on terrorism prevention and integrate it into daily work. The presentation will include case studies and command concepts of emergency management, law enforcement, fire rescue and pre hospital and healthcare response focusing on response to a mass casualty and terror incident. The lecture will provide attendees the opportunity to understand the integrated response system within Israel.

I began training with Plus P Technology in 1994 with Darrell Mulroy and Julio Santiago. I attended all courses offered repeatedly, eventually becoming an Assistant Instructor in 1998. In 2001, I became an Instructor, and in 2003 was appointed Director of Operations following the death of Mr. Mulroy.

These formal courses included basic handgun, advanced handgun, shotgun, night shooting, and a wide variety of specialized course work, including shooting from behind, into and through vehicles to determine efficacy of various weapons in vehicle related combat.

Pistolcraft, Inc. (2003 – Current):

Upon the dissolution of PlusP Technology, I formed Pistolcraft, Inc. to provide a home for the best instructors from PlusP. Pistolcraft is a certifying organization under the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension, being qualified to certify instructors under the Minnesota Personal Protection Act (MPPA) (MN Stat 624.714)

My certificates allow a person carry in over 30 states through a combination of permits from states who accept my instruction, including Florida, New Hampshire, Virginia, and several others.

I have taught firearms skills and the lawful use of force to a wide variety of persons and organizations, including but not limited to; civilians, police, fire, EMS, attorneys, judges, and the training of a military weapons of mass destruction unit. Several of our shooting styles are descended from Julio Santiago, who despite

inventing the night sight, realized the limitations of sights in general in handgun combat and set about with Daryl Mulroy to create a more functional system.

The courses offered through PlusP and Pistolcraft include a significant legal component; use of force statutes and case law, the legal ramifications of the use of force both criminal and civil, as well as other costs (emotional, financial, employment, personal) that come into play when force is used. *All courses center on the basic concept that true self-defense is awareness and avoidance, and the use of force represents a total breakdown of your self-defense plan.*

I have also conducted significant research into the psychology and physiology of combat, an area that few others in this field study or teach. I have also studied the use of rifle, suppressed weapons, and fully automatic weapons through study with a variety of instructors including Front Sight, Hero Gear, and Oleg Volk, in addition to extensive private training in several states.

I have comprehensive experience with reloading and the behavior of various types of ammunition under a variety of conditions through testing in a wide range of applications, as well as skills in gunsmithing.

I also own and operate **Force Management Academy, Inc.** which specializes in the training of awareness, prevention and unarmed self-defense for EMS, fire, police, and civilians.

I have served as Weapons Master / Armorer on a number of film projects, including a film where my work earned me First Associate Producer credit. Responsibilities included set safety, all handling and training of production staff and actors in various weapons and physical skills related matters. Several of these have won awards.
